Organization's Overview

Doers is a humanitarian organization working towards resilience and sustainability in the Himalayan region of India. Our core areas of intervention include disaster risk management, humanitarian response and climate change adaptation.

The Registered Office of Doers is located in Shimla - the capital city of Himachal Pradesh and an Indian state which is at a very high risk of disasters due to its adverse topographic, climatic & geological conditions. Our team has been working in all districts of the state, mainly carrying out capacity building and training related activities in the field of disaster risk management, humanitarian response and climate change adaptation.

Doers came into existence in 2015 when a group of like-minded students, social workers and development professionals came together to discuss the growing risk of disasters in the Himalayan region of India. After the devastating Nepal Earthquake in April 2015, this group had a full-day meeting on 2nd of June, 2015 and unanimously decided to form a non-governmental organization in the state of Himachal Pradesh. Within a few months of focused discussions, strategic planning and preparatory actions, Doers was finally registered under the Himachal Pradesh Societies Registration Act, 2006 on 8th of July, 2015.

Since then, Doers continued to learn more and do better in the area of disaster risk management while gradually integrating the issues pertaining to climate change adaptation, public health and humanitarian response. We believe in 'systems thinking' approach which is vital to risk-informed development and is at the core of our work.

Today, with our commitment to learn more and serve better, Doers is recognized as a trustworthy and dedicated NGO working in the spheres of resilience and sustainability.

Our Goal

Doers has a long-term goal which is embedded into our objectives and vision and mission statements.

Vision

Resilient and climate-smart communities in the Himalayan region of India.

Mission

To develop community resilience against disasters and climate-related risks by carrying out localized, participatory, inter-disciplinary and sustainable interventions.

Objectives

- To create awareness and undertake activities and projects aimed at addressing the issues pertaining to sustainable development, such as- climate change, disaster management, rural development, social justice, corruption, women and youth empowerment and other inter-related subjects.
- To bridge the rural-urban divide in the domains like- education, health, livelihoods and other spheres of sustainable development through developing capacities and leadership skills of the communities, especially youth, for their holistic development.
- To carry out relevant awareness building programmes like- workshops, conferences, exhibitions, seminars, fairs, symposiums and to publish and disseminate useful IEC (Information, Education & Communication) material like books, journals, newsletters, pamphlets, posters, etc. in print or electronic mode, for the advancement of ideas related to sustainable development.
- To undertake participatory research activities, render consultancy or relevant services to the Governmental and Non-Governmental Organizations over the crosscutting issues related to sustainable development.
- To receive donations/grants and acquire/purchase any moveable or immovable property with the financial assistance from Governmental or Non-Governmental Organizations or individuals in the name of society for furtherance of its objectives.

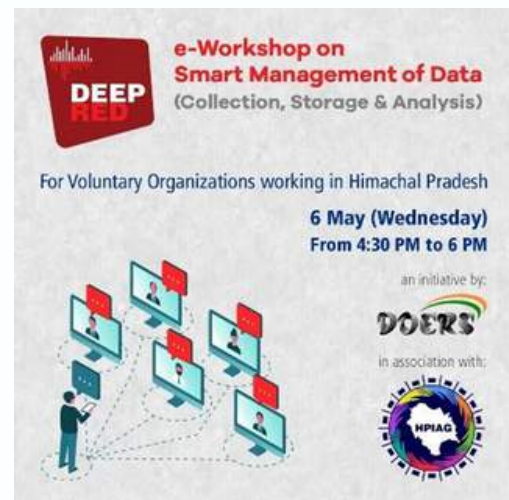
Main Activities

Training Workshops Conducted

As the risk of disasters is increasing all across the globe, Doers is endeavouring to sensitize and train the local communities to prepare for emergency situations through conducting awareness workshops, including the ones conducted as a part of our initiative program 'Data Ecosystem for Effective Planning and Response during Emergencies & Disasters (DEEPRED)

DEEPRED (Data Ecosystem for Effective Planning and Response during Emergencies & Disasters)

- Doers launched the program 'Data Ecosystem for Effective Planning and Response during Emergencies & Disasters (DEEPRED)', which aims at building the institutional capacities on smart data collection, analysis, and visualization as an integral part of disaster risk management by offering valuable insights and intelligence for decision support. The first 2-day e-workshop on Smart Management of Data was conducted on May 6 & 11, 2020.
- The role of data in facilitating risk-informed, inclusive, equitable, and sustainable development is crucial. In recognition of this fact, Team Doers organized a two-day e-workshop on the 'Data Ecosystem for Effective Planning and Response during Emergencies & Disasters (DEEPRED)' on May 16th and 17th, 2020. The workshop was specifically aimed at civil society professionals in India and sought to provide practical guidance and training on using data to improve planning and response efforts during emergencies and disasters. Overall, the workshop was an important initiative that highlights the significance of data in achieving sustainable development goals.



- In the midst of the COVID-19 crisis, Team Doers organized a two-day e-workshop on May 30th and 31st, 2020, focusing on the 'Data Ecosystem for Effective Planning and Response during Emergencies & Disasters (DEEPRED)'.



- On the 6th and 7th of June 2020, Team Doers conducted two-day e-workshops on 'Data Ecosystem for Effective Planning and Response during Emergencies & Disasters (DEEPRED)' for humanitarian professionals and NGO staff. These workshops aimed to improve participants' data collection and analysis skills by providing practical guidance and training on using KoBoToolbox for swift data collection during emergency and disaster situations. The workshops were highly beneficial for professionals seeking to enhance their proficiency in this area.



During the COVID-19 pandemic, Team Doers effectively enhanced the skills of 56 professionals from 25 organizations across 10 states in India through a series of e-Workshops, as part of the DEEPRED program.

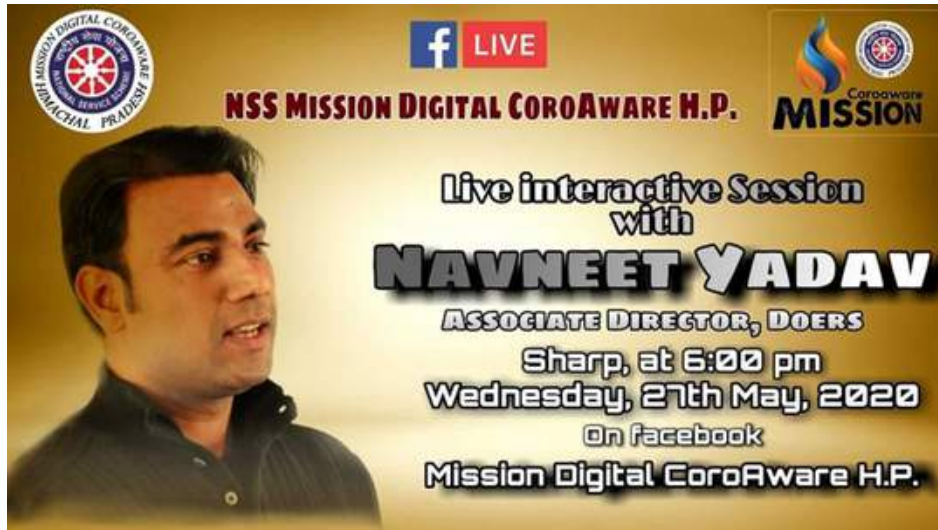

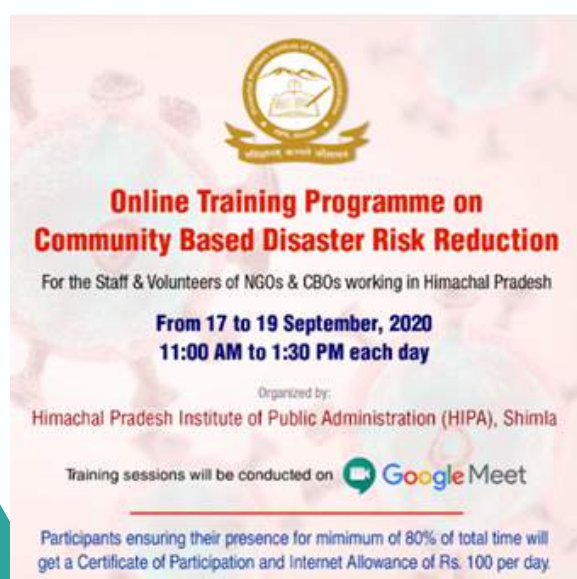

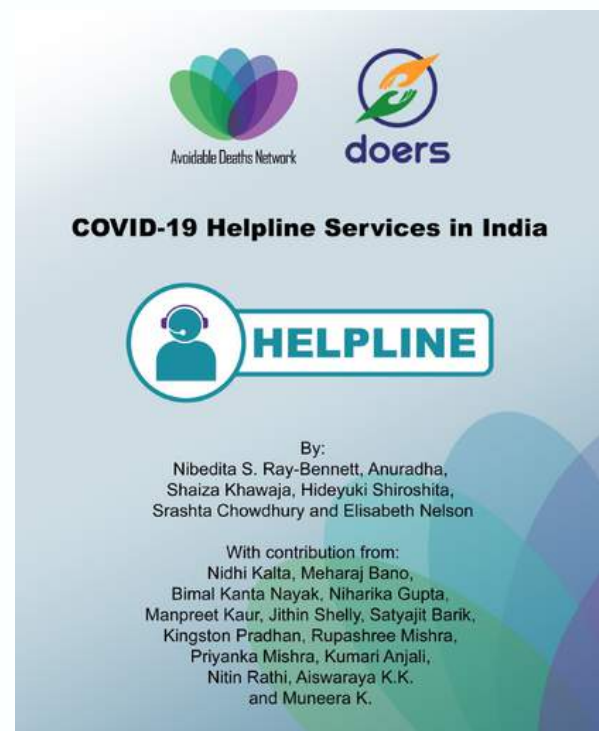

Projects Implemented

We are very pleased to have implemented two projects in Shimla city during this fiscal year. Throughout these endeavors, our team members conducted numerous field visits across the city to gather essential data and map the hydrants. The primary focus of these projects was the redevelopment of Shimla City Disaster Management Plan (CDMP), in addition with the creation of a specialized Fire Management Plan for the city.

City Disaster Management Plan



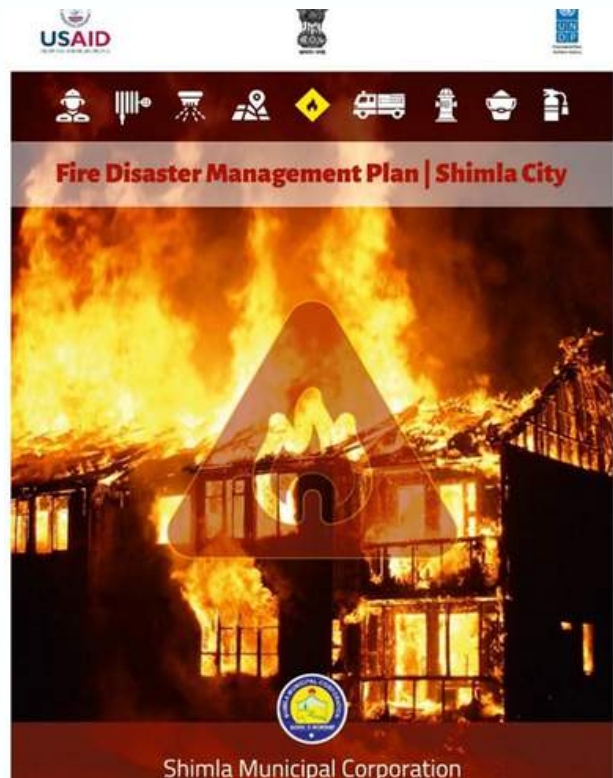
According to the DM Act 2005, every local authority is required to prepare its Disaster Management plan in the supervision of the DDMA. The first DM Plan of Shimla city was drafted by the MC Shimla in the year 2012. However, it was realized that the contents of the plan were not very well structured and more efforts were required to make it more user-friendly. Finally, with the support of UNDP India, the Municipal Corporation Shimla initiated the overhauling of the CDMP which has been carried out by Doers—an experienced organization in the field of Disaster Risk Management. This assignment was undertaken under the USAID-GoI-UNDP project titled 'Enhancing Institutional and

Community Resilience to Disasters and Climate Change implemented at Shimla city.



Fire Disaster Management Plan

Being located in a geo-physically vulnerable area known for its unique climatic conditions, built environment and forest cover, Shimla city is one of the major urban settlements prone to the fire hazards. Under the USAID-Gol-UNDP project titled 'Enhancing Institutional and Community Resilience to Disasters and Climate Change', the Municipal Corporation Shimla has formulated the Fire Disaster Management Plan (FDMP) for the city. Being a consulting agency, Doers helped in mapping all the fire hydrants in the city and guiding them towards the specific requirements for an inclusive Fire Disaster Management Plan at the City level.





Building a Better Response remote learning workshop

Team members of Doers, Ms. Anuradha and Nidhi Kalta attended 'Building a better response remote learning workshop to strengthen the capacity for international humanitarian coordination during the global COVID-19 pandemic jointly organized by International Medical Corps, Concern Worldwide and USAID on August 12, 2020. The aim of the workshop was to help in understanding how the international humanitarian coordination landscape has shifted due to the global COVID-19 pandemic and understand the current and longer-term implications of COVID-19 in relation to humanitarian assistance and international humanitarian coordination.

August 17, 2020. The focus of the webinar was to address the challenges faced by the persons with disabilities amid the pandemic and come up with adaptive strategies to cope up with the “new normal” paradigm.

Web-based training program on Making Cities Resilient

Urban resilience is the key to reduce the vulnerabilities of growing cities. Opening of the training program was done with an understanding related to strategies of Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) and the Sendai Framework and role of cities in response to COVID-19. It also aimed to introduce and familiarize local experts and government officials to South-South and Triangular Cooperation and its importance in disaster risk reduction, public health, and climate change adaptation agenda. One of the session focused on the 'Role of Local Government in Response to COVID-19' where studies of cities were also shared, as well as response to COVID-19 especially for vulnerable people in cities.

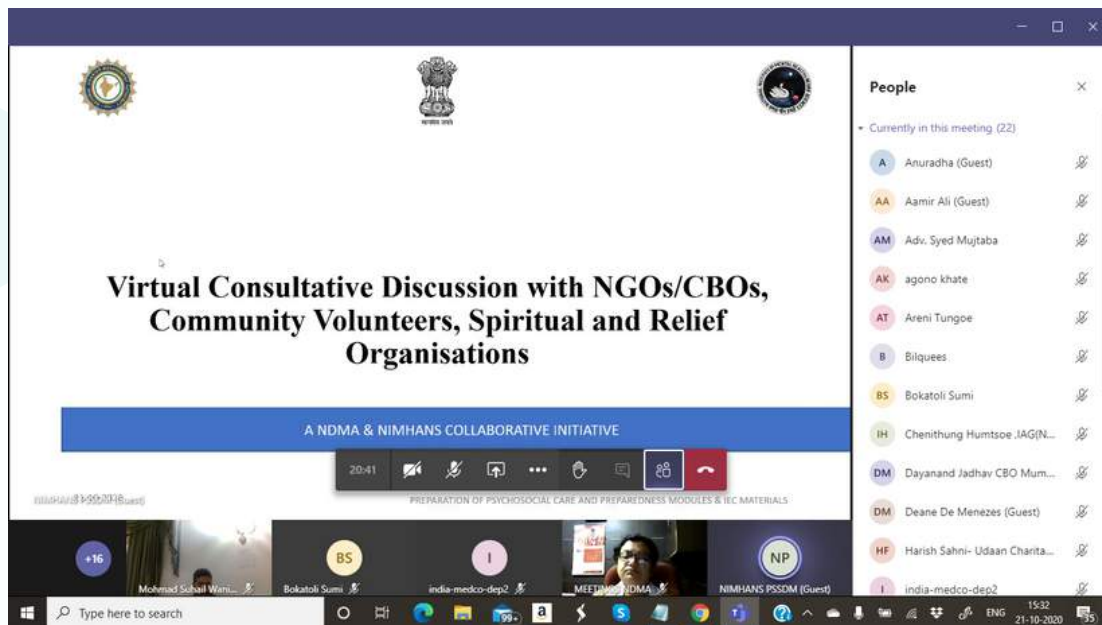
Psychosocial Care in COVID-19 Unlock 5.0
